- 2 All property is sold "as is" and neither the auctioneer nor the AKC Canine Health Foundation makes any representations or warranties of any kind or nature, expressed or implied, with respect to the property, and in no event shall either of them be responsible for the correctness of any catalogue or notices or descriptions of property, nor be deemed to have made, any representations or warranty of physical condition, size, quality, rarity, importance, genuineness, attribution, authenticity, provenance, or historical relevance of the property.
