GENETICS with Dr. Anita Oberbauer. Dr. Oberbauer is Professor and Vice Chair of UC Davis' Department of Animal Science, and serves on the board of the Orthopedic Foundation for Animals. She received the Jim Corbin Award in Companion Animal Biology from the American Society of Animal Science, and has been honored with distinguished teaching awards. Her research focuses on the genetic basis for health disorders, as well as growth and development--specifically, the relationship between skeletal size and body composition.

REPRODUCTION with Dr. Autumn Davidson. Dr. Davidson is past director of the San Rafael vet clinic at Guide Dogs for the Blind, where she supervised the health of the thousand puppies whelped annually. She is currently a clinical professor of medicine and epidemiology at the UC Davis School of Veterinary Medicine, a consultant for the Smithsonian National Zoological Park, and a practitioner at a private clinic. She is a past director of both the Society for Theriogenology and the Institute for Genetic Disease Control, and a recipient of the Hills Animal Welfare and Humane Ethics Award.

DENTISTRY with Dr. Steven Holmstrom. A past president of the American Veterinary Dental Society, Dr. Holmstrom is an instructor, presenter at national and international conferences, academic journal editor, author of numerous research papers and textbooks, and the recipient of several awards of recognition. He has applied his expertise in a remarkable variety of roles, including consultant to Marineland, the Oakland Zoo, and NASA's Ames Research Center.
